SHINE AND SHOW CLASSES & CONCOURS D 'ELEGANCE CLASSES

Section B - Classes, SHINE AND SHOW CLASSES is revised:

To mandate cars with less than 10,000 miles or 16,000 kilometers be entered in the UNDER 10K Class in Show-n-Shine, **OR** transfer to Concours D' Elegance

To mandate cars in the UNDER 10K Class that surpass the 10,000 mile or 16,000 kilometer requirement during the Shine and Show Event season are to remain in the UNDER 10K Class for the remainder of that show season.

Section B - Classes, CONCOURS D 'ELEGANCE is deleted:

UNDER 10K All model years
(Cars in this class must have **All cars with** less than 10,000 miles or 16,000 kilometers showing on the odometer **to be eligible. on the date the Shine-n-Show Event is held must be entered into the UNDER 10k Class.** An entrant may choose to enter their car in Concours D 'Elegance if desired **in lieu of entering the UNDER 10K Class.**

A car entered in the UNDER 10K Class at any time in the competition year shall remain in this class for the duration of that competition year despite mileage exceeding the 10,000 mile or 16,000 kilometer limit during that competition year.

CONCOURS D 'ELEGANCE CLASSES

C-1	1953 - 1962
C-2	1963 - 1967
C-3	1968 - 1982
C-4	1984 - 1996
C-5 (Coupe & Convertible are judged as one class)	1997 - 2004
C-6 (Coupe & Convertible are judged as one class)	2005 - Current model year

Any street-driven vehicle, regardless of class, must provide proof of current and valid vehicle registration and proof of liability insurance upon request at the time of registration. A car trailered to an event may be exempt from this requirement.
