

Rules Change Proposal

Explanation of the Proposal:

In the past, NWACC had received a entry fee from clubs that hosted NWACC-sanctioned car shows and autocross events. The money returned to NWACC had been used for the purchase of all Seasonal Championship Awards. When a previous rules change removed this requirement, NWACC no longer had an income source for awards.

When NWACC began hosting autocross events, the net proceeds from these events went towards all award purchases. Awards for Shine and Show were purchased with autocross entry proceeds. The number of awards for Shine and Show typically have been the same as the number of autocross awards.

Going back to a return of an entry fee amount will help offset the cost of awards for Shine and Show so that autocross events will not be the only source of income for awards purchases.

New Rule in the Competition Code:

Section 5 – Entry Fees

3. \$3.00 of every entry fee for an NWACC-Sanctioned event shall be returned to NWACC by the host club. Fees shall only apply to the entrants that are awarded NWACC Seasonal Championship Points. Fees shall not apply to “People’s Choice” or “Display Only” entrants.
