

RULE CHANGE PROPOSAL

Show Classes – NWACC Shine and Show Judging Sheets

Explanation of the proposed change:

The Shine and Show judging sheets were revised in 2011 increasing the total available scoring points from 100 to 200 and also increasing the minimum point deduction from $\frac{1}{2}$ (one half) points to 2 points with no fractions.

The revised 2011 Shine and Show Judging Sheets worked well during the 2011 show season. However, the minimum 2 point deduction is believed to be extreme by both judges and show entrants when applied to the minor deductible items normally discovered during judging. On several entrant judging sheets, multiple 2 point deductions were made with each of several minor items documented in a judging section. This resulted in a very large (questionable) point deduction for that section which then resulted in very low overall score for the entrants.

This proposal reduces the minimum point deduction to one (1) point for the Shine and Show Judging Sheets.

New Requirement:

Minimum point deduction (in each judging section) shall be one (1) point with no fractional point deductions.
